TODAY'S MESSAGE


The historical background of the letter to the Galatians indicates that Paul is vehemently rejecting any different status or claim of the Jewish Christians beside or above that of Gentile believers before God. Baptized Jews and Gentiles are all in Christ, are "all sons of God through faith in Jesus Christ." Consequently, there is neither Jew nor Greek. If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise. How could language state it any more conclusively or unambiguously? Yet, Paul does not want to be misunderstood, and so he has more to say to those who still claim special promise for ethnic Israel. -- Hans LaRondelle

It is to that passage we turn this morning.

Today's message is a review of the topic we considered four years ago, but it is an important one with enormous significance today as we watch what is happening in the Middle-East.

One of the best books you can read on the topic of the biblical understanding of modern Israel is *The Israel of God in Prophecy*, by Hans LaRondelle.


