TODAY'S MESSAGE

The historical background of the letter to the Galatians indicates that Paul is vehemently rejecting any different status or claim of the Jewish Christians beside or above that of Gentile believers before God. Baptized Jews and Gentiles are all in Christ, are "all sons of God through faith in Jesus Christ." Consequently, there is neither Jew nor Greek. If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise. How could language state it any more conclusively or unambiguously? Yet, Paul does not want to be misunderstood, and so he has more to say to those who still claim special promise for ethnic Israel.

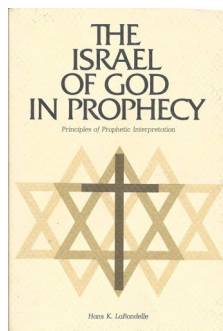

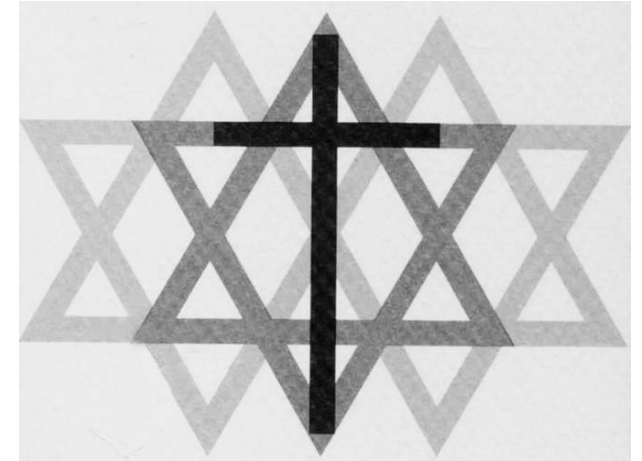
