## TODAY'S MESSAGE

### Children's Church Today at 11:00 am in the Fellowship Hall



Children's Church is the monthly worship service geared for kids ages 4-11. All children are invited.

A major problem in applying the ancient prophetic messages to our times is that many modern interpreters manifest a total disregard for the essential theological – specifically the Christological -- dimension of the Old Testament prophecies. The prophetic view of history was never directed to secular events of a political nature, disconnected from the Messiah and His people.

Each Bible prophet kept his promises of blessing or threats of doom solidly and consistently in the focus of redemptive history. To interpret prophetic messages as mere predictions of current social and political events in the Middle East would essentially transform the God of Israel into a soothsayer. The hallmark of soothsaying has always been to predict future events outside of redemptive history, disconnected from the true Messiah and the messianic people. When God speaks, His name is at stake in being faithful to His covenant which is centered in Jesus Christ and confirmed by Jesus Christ. From Genesis to Revelation the focus of all biblical prophecies is consistently on God's eternal purpose for the reconciliation of heaven and earth through Jesus Christ.

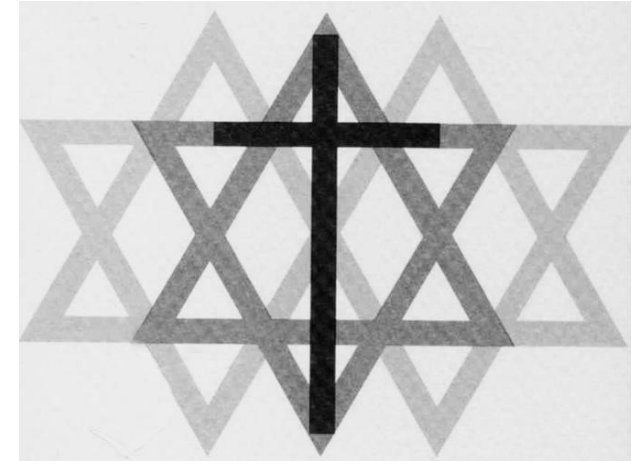
